



## **NIC Skilled Nursing Boot Camp**



The **Skilled Nursing Boot Camp: Evaluating the Investment Landscape** course will define how value is created in skilled nursing. It is designed both for people who are new to the industry and those who desire to stay current in underwriting skilled nursing properties. This course will orient participants to the nuances of skilled nursing. Participants will be able to understand the unique risks associated with skilled nursing and how they may be mitigated.


